

When Asbury received it's accreditation and began to receive UMC students, Dr. Doug and several other pastors from our conference saw the hardships that Asbury Seminary students faced because of debt from their seminary tuition. They resolved to begin this foundation and help address that burden. They partnered together to give these students the support and encouragement needed to live out God's call in ministry.

Their hope was that one day they could support students in such a way that they could graduate debt free. Thanks to the generosity of hundreds of faithful people, that day has become a reality. We are grateful to those like Dr. Newton who had a vision to meet a need and took faithful action trusting God to fulfill it!

Equipping the Called

Our mission is to provide generous scholarships to qualified students from the Alabama Emerald Coast region who are studying higher education at Asbury Theological Seminary, enabling them to receive a quality graduate degree without being burdened by student loan debt.

The high cost of a seminary education causes substantial financial pressure on our students and their families. The average student loan debt among seminary students who rely on loans is \$33,537. We provide financial aid equaling 50% of student tuition for all of our qualified applicants.
